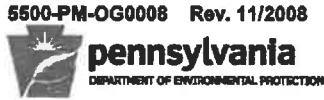

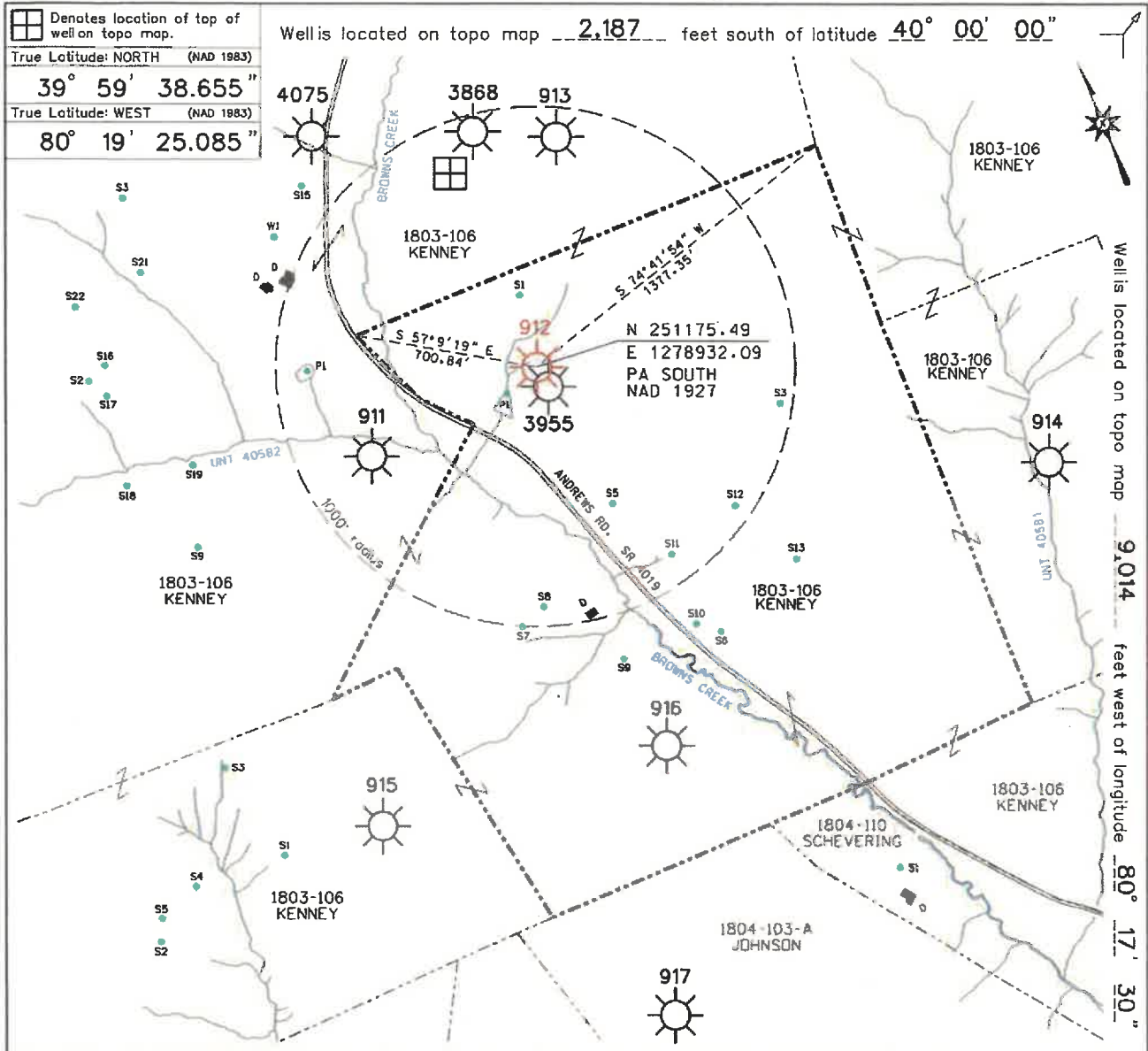

This Indenture, made this 31st day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two.

Between J. Davis Reiter and Eusebia Reiter, his wife, of Morris Township, Greene County and State of Pennsylvania

parties of the first part and George F. Huld of the same place: party of the second part:

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand three hundred and three dollars and fifty cents (\$3303.50) lawful money of the United States of America unto them well and truly paid by the said party of the second part, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns

All the east of the Pittsburg or Iron vein in and under all that certain tract of land situate in the Township of Morris, County of Greene and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a stone corner to lands of E. H. Andrew and George Hurdell, thence by lands of said George Hurdell and Hugh Huld North five and three-fourths degrees West (5.75° W.) one hundred and forty four (144) perches to a white oak, thence by lands of Hugh Huld South eighty nine and one-fourth degrees West (89.25° W.) forty and fifty hundredths (40.50) perches to a stake, thence by same North seven degrees (3.7° E.) four and seven tenths (4.7) perches to a stake, thence by same North twenty seven degrees West (27.77° W.) nine feet and thirty hundredths (9.30) perches to a stone, thence by lands of Henry Drier, James Kanner Sr. Barton and M. Sanders South eighty nine and one-fourth degrees West (89.25° W.) one hundred and ninety six and forty one hundredths (196.40) perches to a gum stump, thence by lands of Abraham Reiter, North two and one-half degrees East (2.5° E.) sixty seven and fifty one hundredths (67.50) perches to a stake, thence by land of E. H. Andrew North eighty nine and one-half degrees East (89.5° E.) one hundred two and eighty one hundredths (102.80) perches to a stone, thence by same North fifty four degrees East (54° E.) seventy six and thirty one hundredths (76.30) perches to a point in road, thence by same North forty degrees West (40° W.) eighteen (18) perches to a point in road, thence by same North thirty six and one-half degrees West (36.5° W.) twenty and ninety one hundredths (20.90) perches to a point in road, thence by same North eighty nine degrees and thirty

 privilege of mining and removing through said described prop-
 erty, other coal belonging to said party of the second part, his
 heirs and assigns; or which may hereafter be assigned.

First parties reserve the right to drill through said
 coal, for oil, gas and other minerals.

The parties of the first part hereby further grant to the
 party of the second part the right to purchase any number of
 acres of said described land by paying therefor the sum of
 \$100.00 Hundred and fifty dollars per acre for as much as is
 used.

Together with all and singular the said property, improvements
 ways, waters, water courses, rights, liberties, privileges, hereditaments
 and appurtenances whatsoever thereto belonging, or in anywise
 appertaining and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues
 and profits thereof; and with the estate, right, title, interest, prop-
 erty, claims and demand whatsoever, of the said parties of the
 first part, in law, equity or otherwise known or in and to the same
 and every part thereof except the right to drill for oil, gas and other
 minerals as above reserved.

To have and to hold the said Pittsburg or River view of
 coal and mining rights, together with the hereditaments and
 premises hereby granted or mentioned, and intended as to be, with
 the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs
 and assigns, to and for the only proper use and behoof of the
 said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said J. Davis Reitan and Evelyn Reitan, his wife,
 the said parties of the first part for themselves and their heirs, ex-
 ecutors and administrators, do by these presents covenant, grant
 and agree it and with the said party of the second part, his
 heirs and assigns, that they the said parties of the first part,
 and their heirs, all and singular the hereditaments and prem-
 ises herein above described and granted or mentioned; and
 intended as to be, with the appurtenances, unto the said

party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against them the said parties of the first part, and their heirs, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, shall and will warrant and forever defend;

The said Eveline Rutan being of full age, and by me examined separate and apart from her said husband, and the contents of the said indenture being first made fully known to her, declared that she did, voluntarily, of her own free will and accord, sign and seal said as her act and deed, to give the same without any coercion or compulsion of her said husband.
