ORDER

NOW this 27th day of April, 2026, pursuant to Section 13(c) of the Coal and Gas Resource Coordination Act, Act of December 18, 1984, P.L. 1069, 58 P.S. §§ 501-518, the Department of Environmental Protection hereby authorizes Leatherwood, LLC. (the "Applicant") to plug Well No. 4 on the C.S. Day farm, Morris Township, Greene County, identified in the application attached hereto. Such plugging is to be conducted in accordance with the manner outlined in 25 Pa. Code §§ 78.91, 78.92 and 78.93 of the rules and regulations.

This authorization is conditioned on the Applicant's compliance with all applicable provisions of the Oil and Gas Act of 2012, 58 Pa. C.S. §§ 2301-3504; the Clean Streams Law, the Act of June 22, 1937, P.L. 1987, *as amended*, 35 P.S. §§ 691.1-691.1001; the Coal and Gas Resource Coordination Act, 58 P.S. §§ 501-518, and all other applicable laws.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. Section 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, 400 Market Street, P.O. Box 8457, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, 717-787-3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800-654-5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. A Notice of Appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure may be obtained online at www.ehb.pa.gov or by contacting the Secretary to the Board at 717-787-3483. The Notice of Appeal form and the Board's rules are also available in braille and on audiotape from the Secretary to the Board. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

This authorization does not purport to confer any rights of ownership or access, nor to confirm title in any person, nor to confer any rights for payment of any kind, to any other person or property owner.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST REACH THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS. YOU DO NOT NEED A LAWYER TO FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE BOARD.

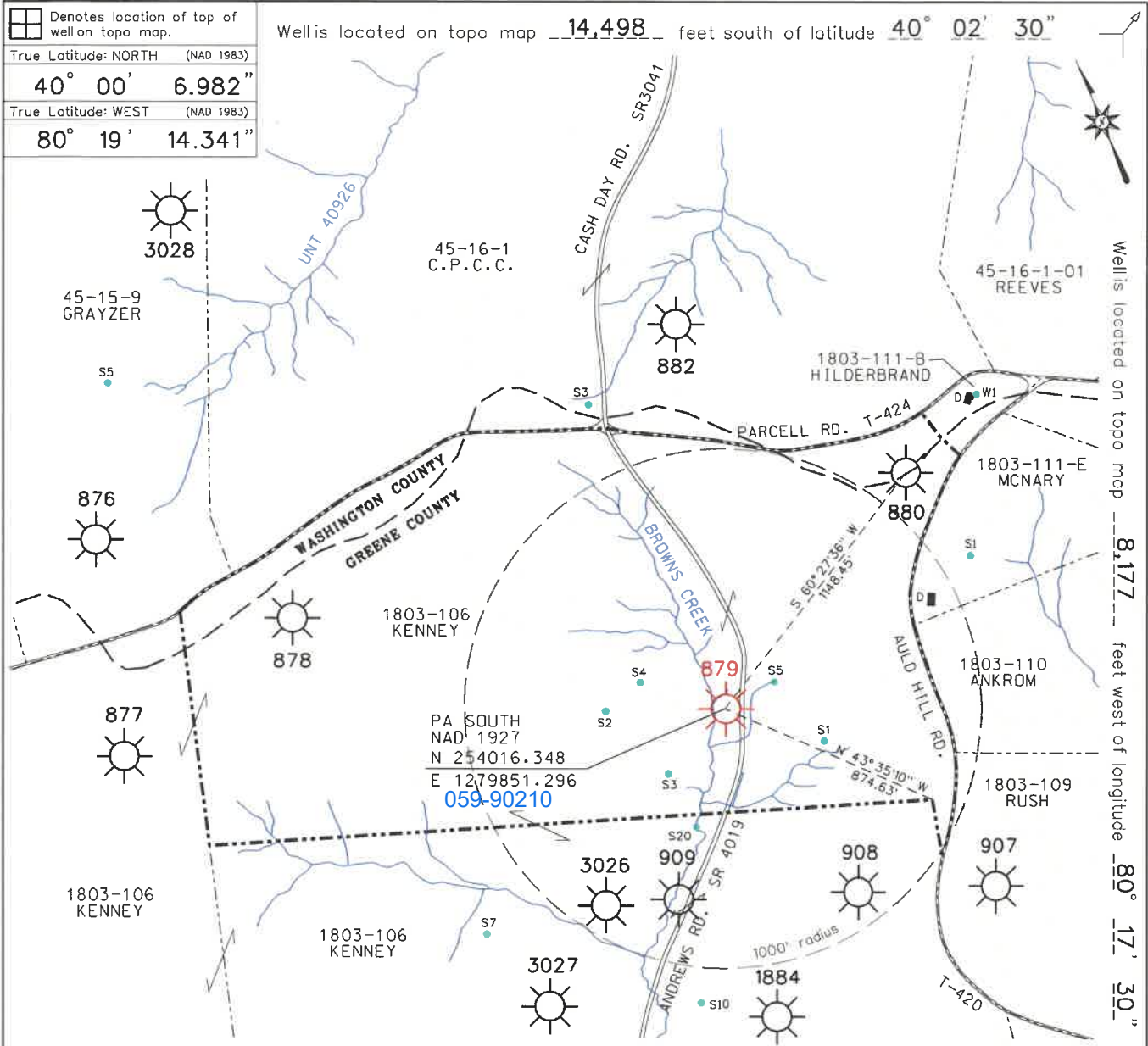

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING, therefrom and thereout, to the Grantors, their heirs and assigns, all the oil and gas including the present producing wells in and under two of the tracts included in the foregoing description designated as the Residence Farm of 103 Acres, more or less, and described in Deed Book 5 '2' page 228, And the Hill Farm of 110 Acres, more or less, described in Deed Book 328 page 360 and one-half of the oil and gas and gas rental and royalty in, under and upon the remainder of the 346 Acres, more or less, herein described, together with the rights to drill and operate for the same in the usual and ordinary manner by the present methods or by such other methods as may be in use at such time as further operations are or may be carried on for the development of the said premises, for the production of oil and gas.

WHEREAS, J. Wiley Day, widower, died January 3, 1912, a resident of the Township of Morris, County of Washington, Pennsylvania, intestate and survived by the following children as his sole heirs and next of kin: Cassius S. Day, Anna S. Day, Elizabeth Day Beck, Joseph S. Day, Bess Day Ledwith and John Wiley Day.

And the said John Wiley Day named in the foregoing recited Will, died testate November 15, 1918, and his last Will duly probated January 29, 1919, is of record in the Register's Office of Washington County, Pa., in Will Book 31, page 493 wherein he divided his real estate to his brothers and sisters, namely Cassius S. Day, Anna Blanche Day, Joseph S. Day, Mrs. J.R. Ledwith and Mrs. F.E. Beck, his five brothers and sisters above named.

And the said Joseph S. Day died March 18, 1922, a resident of the Township of Morris, County of Washington, Pennsylvania, intestate and unmarried, leaving to survive him as his sole heirs and next of kin, his four surviving brothers, and sisters above named.

And the said Elizabeth Day Beck, widow of Fred A. Beck, died December 26, 1930,

a resident of Berkeley, County of Alameda, State of California, leaving a Will dated November 5, 1930, and duly admitted to probate in said county, wherein and whereby she devised her entire estate in equal shares to her brother, Cassius S. Day (who was named Executor therein and duly qualified as such on January 26, 1931, by appointment of the Superior Court of the State of California, in and for the County of Alameda) and to her sisters, Anna S. Day and Beas Day Ledwith.

And the said Anna S. Day died September 23, 1945, a resident of the Township of Morris, County of Washington, Pennsylvania, unmarried and leaving a Will dated March 10, 1933, and duly admitted to probate in said County, wherein and whereby she devised her entire estate in equal shares to her brother, Cassius S. Day, her sister, Beas Day Ledwith and her nephew, Richard Wiley Ledwith (who is the Executor named in such Will and who was duly appointed as such on September 28, 1945 by the Register of Wills in and for said County.

SUBJECT to the oil and gas leases now in and upon the said premises or any part thereof, and subject to pipe line, telephone line and other easements in and upon the premises hereinbefore described.

An exemplification of the Will of Elizabeth E. Day Beck is on record in the Register's Office of Washington County, Pa., in Will Book 68 page 423.

And the said Cassius S. Day, Beas Day Ledwith and Richard Wiley Ledwith, grantors will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed.

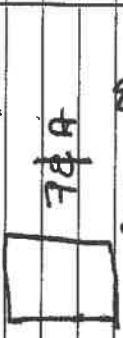

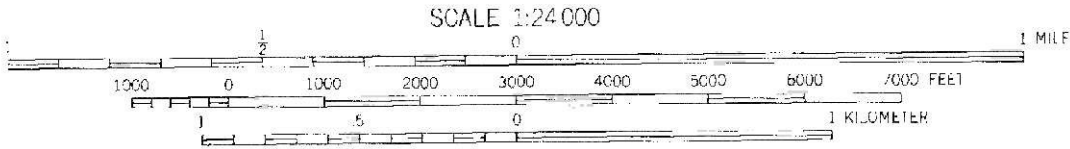
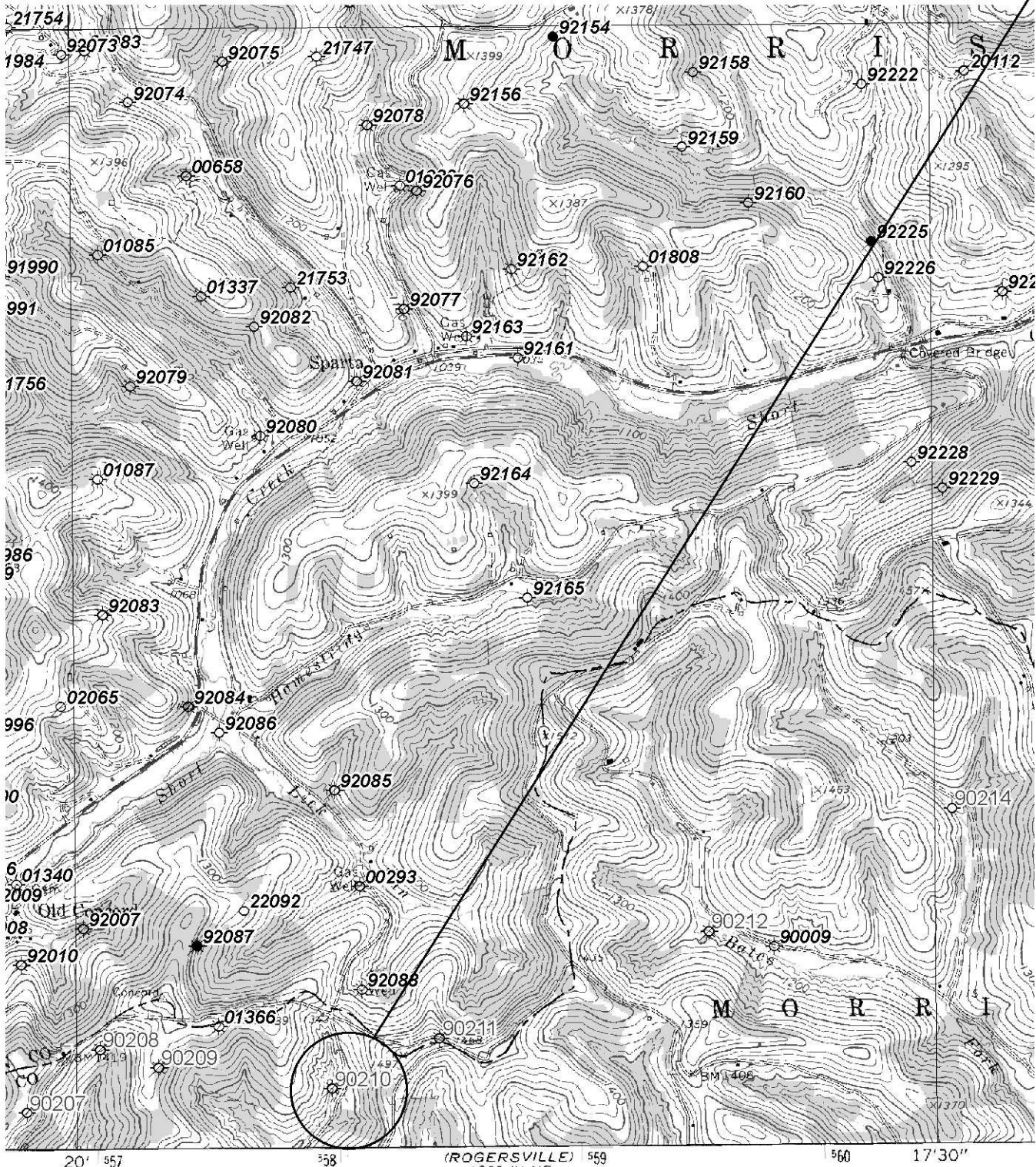
