This permit covering the well operator and well location shown above is evidence of permission granted to conduct activities in accordance with the Oil and Gas Act and the Oil and Gas Conservation Law, if the well is subject to that act and any rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, subject to the conditions contained herein and in accordance with the application submitted for this permit. This permit does not convey any property rights.

This permit and the permittee's authority to conduct the activities authorized by this permit are conditioned upon operator's compliance with applicable law and regulations.

Notification must be given to the district oil and gas inspector, the surface landowner and political subdivision of the date well drilling will begin at least 24 hours prior to commencement of drilling activities.

The permittee hereby authorizes and consents to allow, without delay, employees or agents of the Department to have access to and to inspect all areas upon presentation of appropriate credentials, without advance notice or a search warrant. This includes any property, facility, operation or activity governed by the Oil and Gas Act, the Oil and Gas Conservation Law, the Coal and Gas Resource Coordination Act and other statutes applicable to oil and gas activities administered by the Department. The authorization and consent shall include consent to the Department to collect samples of wastewaters or gases, to take photographs, to perform measurements, surveys, and other tests, to inspect any monitoring equipment, to inspect the methods of operation and disposal, and to inspect and copy documents required by the Department to be maintained. The authorization and consent includes consent to the Department to examine books, papers, and records pertinent to any matter under investigation pursuant to the Oil and Gas Act or pertinent to a determination of whether the operator is in compliance with the above referenced statutes. This condition in no way limits any other powers granted to the Department under the Oil and Gas Act and other statutes, rules and regulations applicable to these activities as administered by the Department.

This permit does not relieve the operator from the obligation to comply with the Clean Streams Law and all statutes, rules and regulations administered by the Department.

Special Permit Conditions:

1. Contact the Inspector at least 24 hours prior to commencing any frac/stimulation procedures.
2. This permit is conditioned upon the well operator obtaining all appropriate approvals, including local, municipal and zoning approvals, and any revision or modification of those approvals.
3. The natural flow regime and water quality in this watershed are important to maintaining habitats occupied by rare fish and mussels. Take measures to maintain a natural flow regime, high water quality, and quantity. Maintenance or restoration of the riparian corridor will aid in connecting habitats and improving water quality and quantity for fish and mussels. Retain or (restore if not already present) a riparian buffer (100 to 300 feet if possible) on each side of the waterway (river, stream, creek). This buffer should be vegetated with native plant species. Where streambanks have become badly eroded (e.g., due to previous removal of native riparian vegetation), streambank fencing and/or bioengineering restoration techniques are necessary (geotextile, root wads, vegetative stabilization), rather than riprapping the streambanks; removing gravel bars; or attempting to dredge, ditch, channelize, or widen the stream. Use stringent erosion and sedimentation controls before, during, and after project implementation to ensure that sediment and contaminants do not enter waterway(s) (rivers, creeks, streams, tributaries) or waterbodies (lakes, ponds).

This permit expires **07/15/2027** unless drilling is commenced on or before that date and prosecuted with due diligence.

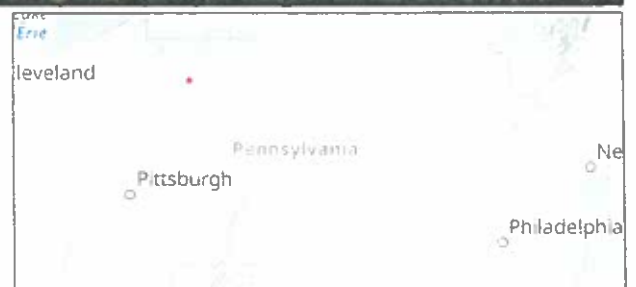

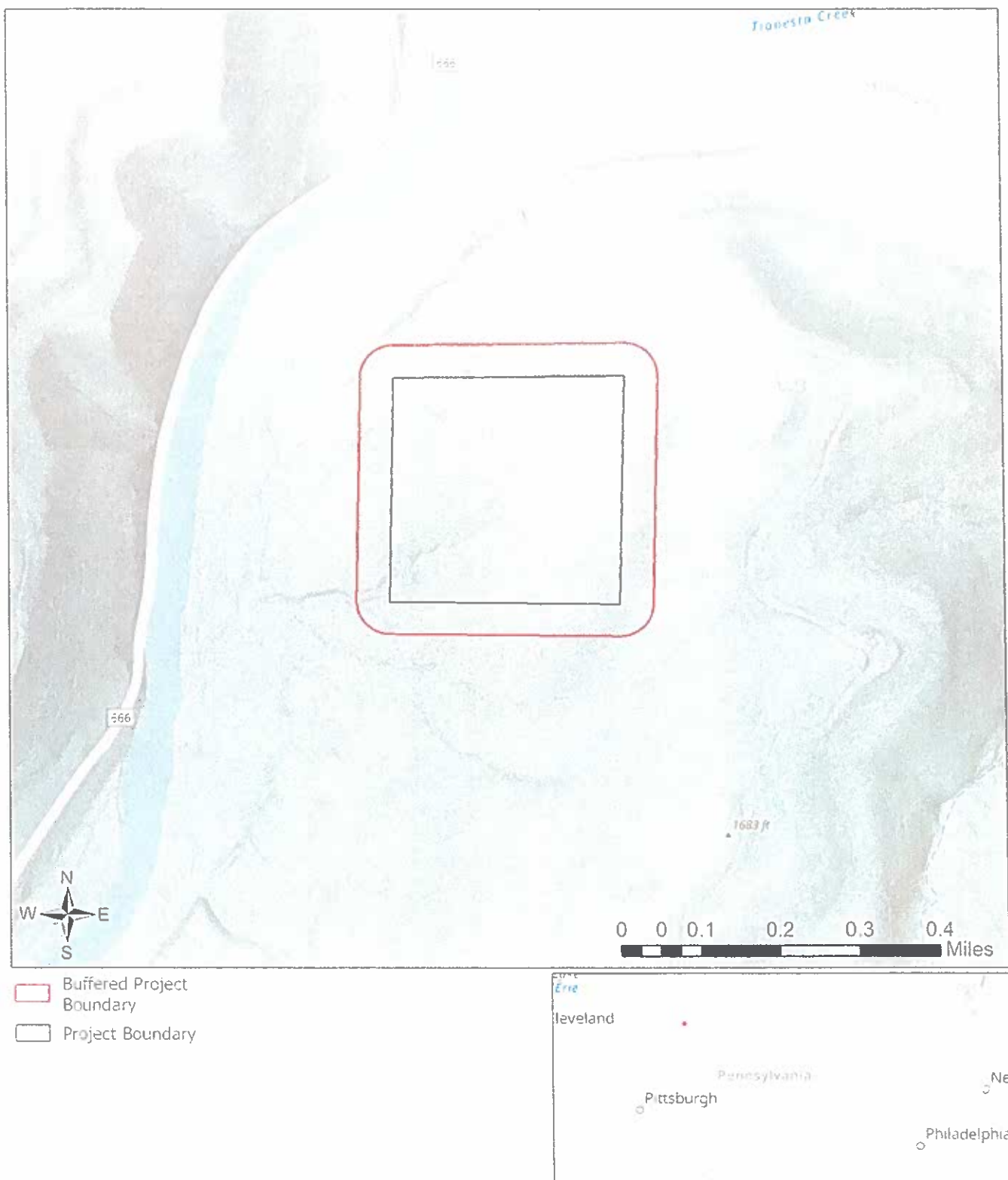


-  Buffered Project Boundary

Thank you for submitting Pennsylvania Natural Diversity Inventory (PNDI) Environmental Review Receipt *project_receipt_phr_clinger_lease_wt_5215_863893_FINAL_1.pdf* for review. The Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC) screened this project for potential impacts to species and resources of concern under PGC responsibility, which includes birds and mammals only.

No Impact Anticipated – PNDI Species

PNDI records indicate species or resources of concern are located within the vicinity of the project. However, based on the information you submitted concerning the nature of the project, the immediate location, and our detailed resource information, the PGC has determined that no impact is likely as long as no trees are cleared for this project. Therefore, no further coordination with the PGC will be necessary for this project at this time.

Conservation Measures

The project is within the Allegheny National Forest, an area where the abundance and species richness of various area-sensitive forest bird species are among the highest in the state. Area-sensitive forest bird species are those species that require a large expanse of relatively contiguous (unfragmented) forest to maintain their populations. The species found in this area are listed as species of greatest conservation need in Pennsylvania's Wildlife Action Plan (WAP). The WAP was designed to proactively manage and safeguard the state's declining fish and wildlife resources, and sets a framework to conserve Pennsylvania's diverse wildlife, maintain their role in ecological processes, and protect and enhance species of conservation concern (not just imperiled species). Although these area-sensitive forest bird species are not currently listed as threatened or endangered, and do not produce potential conflicts for projects reviewed using the on-line PNDI Environmental Review Tool, their populations and requisite habitat are either in decline, or are vulnerable to decline in the state.

As a result, the PGC is recommending that PennHills Resources, LLC consider the following to minimize impacts to these area-sensitive forest bird species and minimize additional fragmentation of the forested tracts throughout the project area:

- Minimize disturbance within the project area to only that which is absolutely necessary (including continuing to co-locate development with existing disturbed areas), and avoid grubbing where possible to encourage the re-establishment of woody vegetation;
- Maximize the rotation of any future mowing and/or clearing within the project area to allow for the establishment of more beneficial wildlife habitat;
- Perform initial tree clearing for the project between August 15th and April 15th;
- Use the following seed mixes, or similar herbaceous seed mixes that will minimize competition with volunteer woody plant species, while offering additional wildlife habitat and food sources within the project area:

PNDI Form - Yes, there are no trees being removed as part of this project. It is a forested area, but in the area of the construction there will be no tree disturbance and/or removal.

Coordination Form - The USFWS had a "conservation measure" shown on the original PNDI submission. The first paragraph under the USFWS it states that no impacts are anticipated and that no further consultation/coordination is required. My understanding from this is that no other documentation is needed so I did not put it onto the coordination form. Please advice, if they aren't requiring anything I'm not sure why I would need to note it.

In section 2 of under response to question(s) asked, your response to question 1 indicates there will be no disturbance to trees such as tree cutting (or other means of knocking down, or bringing down trees, tree topping, or tree trimming), pesticide/herbicide application, or prescribed fire. Page 2 of the PNDI shows the well sites are located in a forested area. If a change to question 1 results in a change to the outcome of the PNDI, then the coordination of a well location with public resources form will need to be updated.
