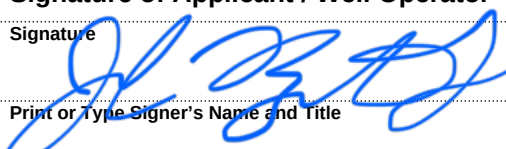

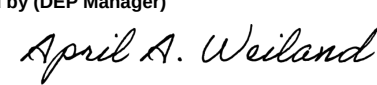
EQT is requesting approval for the optional setting of inflatable packers downhole at Department approved locations outside of regulation 20ft intervals above oil, gas, and water bearing zones. All inflatable packers will be installed with 10'-20' of sand or 6% or greater gel on top of them. These mechanical plugs in conjunction with Class A or Class L cement will help ensure all vertical gas flow in the wellbore is stopped.

EQT will communicate to DEP the intended setting depths of all inflatable packers prior to placement. Should EQT be unable to place an inflatable packer in the intended location, EQT will inform the Oil and Gas Inspector. If EQT identifies the wellbore condition is not supportive of implementing this alternative method, EQT will inform the Oil and Gas Inspector and Oil and Gas Inspector Supervisor and will provide an email requesting to withdraw the alternative method.
